ELECTION CAMPAIGN DONATION RETURNS

In accordance with Section 62 of the *Local Government Act 1989*, each candidate in the election must give an election campaign donation return to the Chief Executive Officer, within 40 days of election day.

The return gives details of any gifts received by the candidate, or on behalf of the candidate, during the election period, used for or in connection with the election campaign. This includes goods or services.
